

PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.





- 2. Start installation on driver's side. Remove factory tape covering holes on the rocker panel. These holes will be were the M8 nut clips (Item 6) will be installed. **See Figure 1 and 2**
- 3. Hold up mounting bracket (Item 2) and loosely install (2) M8 hex head cap screw (Item 11), (2) M8 lock washer (Item 12), and (2) M8 flat washer (Item 13) into previously installed M8 nut clips. Then loosely install M8 hardware to mounting bracket and holes in the pinch weld; (1) M8 hex nut (item 10), (2) lock washer (Item 9), (2) M8 flat washers (Item 8), and (2) M8 button head cap screw (Item 7). Similar installation for center mounting bracket. **See Figure 1 and 2.** (**Note:** See page 3 for bracket orientation)
- 4. Repeat steps **2-3** for all other mounting locations.





- 5. When installing board to bracket, tilt the board downward to insert into center mounting location. See Figure 3.
- 6. For Step Board installation to the previously installed mounting brackets use the supplied short M8 bolts and M8 hardware, then loosely install. **See Figure 4 and 5.**
- 7. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M8 hardware to 20 ft-lbs.

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
