






PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- To install the two Outer Frame Mounting Brackets and the two Inner Frame Mounting Brackets, remove the tow hook bolts and use them to install the Frame Brackets. If the vehicle is not equipped with tow hooks use the supplied M12 Hex Cap Screws and M12 hardware to mount the brackets (Items 14 – 17). *Note:* Use a sharp utility knife to cutout an opening to allow the Grille Guard mounting brackets to pass through the tow hook cavity. The tow hooks remain in their stock position in the frame rails.
- 3. Install the Outer Frame Mounting Brackets on the outer side of the tow hooks.
- 4. Attach the Inner Frame Brackets to the Outer Frame Brackets using (1) M12 Hex Cap Screw, (1) M12 Lock Washer, (2) M12 Small Flat Washers, and (1) M12 Hex Nuts (Items 14 - 17). Note: The driver side Outer Frame Mounting Bracket mounts to one tow hook bolt (Figure 1) and the driver side Inner Frame Mounting Bracket mounts to two tow hook bolts (Figure 2). The passenger side Outer Frame Mounting Bracket mounts to two tow hook bolts (Figure 3) and the passenger side Inner Frame Mounting Bracket mounts to one tow hook bolt (Figure 4).










- 5. Open the hood and remove the radiator cover to access the factory grille shell. Use a small flat head screw driver to remove the retainer plugs from the plastic shroud.
- 6. Remove the two outer bolts from the chrome grille shell.
- 7. Using a pair of needle nose pliers squeeze the six grille mounting clips. Begin from one end of the grille and insert a small screwdriver into the clips to prevent them from popping back into place. Remove the chrome grille by pulling on it gently and evenly.
- 8. Starting on the driver side remove the long M14 bolt that secures the bumper to the frame. Next, remove the M10 bolt that secures the bumper bracket to the bumper shell. Using the long factory M14 bolt, the supplied M10 Hex Head Cap Screw, Washer, Lock Washer (Items 22 24), and the supplied spacer, attach the Driver Top Bracket to the vehicle as shown in Figure 5. Leave this bracket loose for further adjustment.
- 9. Repeat for the Passenger Side.
- 10. Reinstall the factory grille shell at this time, line up the clips and gently push it into place. Do not reinstall top covers at this time.
- 11. With help position the Grille Guard Base (**Item 1**) on the outer side of the Grille Guard Mounting Brackets. Attach the Grille Guard to the Mounting Brackets using (6) M12 Hex Socket Button Head Screw, (6) M12 Lock Washers, (12) M12 Large Flat Washers, and (6) M12 Hex Nuts (**Items 10-13**). See **Figure 6** for reference.
- 12. Attach the Grille Guard Base to the Top Brackets using the included (2) M10 Hex Socket Button head Screw, (2) M10 Lock Washers, (4) M10 Flat Washers and (2) M10 Hex Nuts (Items 18-21). Do not tighten at this time.
- 13. Level and adjust the Grille Guard as needed then tighten all hardware. Torque all M14 hardware to 70-80 ft-lbs., M12 hardware to 45-50 ft-lbs., M10 hardware to 25-30 ft-lbs. A long extension is necessary to tighten the factory M14 bolts.
- 14. Re-install the top plastic shroud.








On polished grille guards. Anti-reflective tape is included to help reduce the amount of glare reflected from the headlights. It should be applied on the top tube section of the grille guard wings as shown on the illustration. Tape may need to be cut to correct length.

- 15. Using supplied M8 hardware (**Items 25-27**), mount the HDX Driver and Passenger Wings (**Items 2-3**) to the Grille Guard Base. See **Figure 7** for reference.
- 16. Align and adjust the HDX Grille Guard Base, HDX Wings, and Mounting Brackets as needed. Then fully tighten all hardware at this time. Tighten and torque all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs..
