


PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Start by removing two factory clips in order to remove the front fender trim pieces shown. Repeat for both sides. See **Figure 1** for reference.
- 3. Remove the single bolt on each side inside the fender well. See Figure 2 for reference






- 4. Remove the headlights on both sides by removing the two bolts shown in **Figure** 3. Unplug the headlights and tilt the headlights back and forth gently to release the plastic clip at the bottom of the headlights in order to remove them.
- 5. Unclip the bumper retaining clip at the bottom of the headlight bezel. Repeat on the opposite side. See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 6. Remove the plastic clips and fasteners along the top side of the bumper. Also remove the 10MM fasteners along the bottom of the front bumper. See **Figure 5** for reference.









7. Remove the license plate and factory license plate holder. Remove the two bolts and carefully pull off the bumper assembly. See **Figures 6 & 7** for reference. *Note: Make sure any wiring connectors secured to the bumper are unplugged prior to removal.*













TRIMMING INSTRUCTIONS


- 9. <u>For model years 2015-2019</u>: Use the larger provided templates to cut out the bumper. See Figure 10 for reference.
- 10. For model years 2020-2021: Use the smaller provided templates to cut out the bumper. See Figure 11 for reference.
- Align templates as shown below on both driver and passenger sides.
- Cut out the section shown on the template with a 2" hole saw.






- 11. After trimming the bumper, reinstall the bumper onto the vehicle.
- 12. Using the supplied M10 hardware (Items 22-23), install the Upper Support Brackets to the front of the vehicle frame using the upper mounting locations. See **Figures 12 & 13** for reference.






13. Using the supplied M10 and M12 hardware, loosely assemble the Lower Mounting Bracket, Lower Support Bracket, and Spacer to the vehicle's frame on each side. See **Figures 14 & 15** for reference.






- 14. Using the supplied M10 and M12 hardware, loosely assemble the Grille Guard Base (Item 1) to the previously installed mounting brackets. See **Figure 16** for reference.
- 15. Adjust the Grille Guard Base as needed. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M10 to 35-40 ft-lbs., M12 to 55-60 ft-lbs.



- 16. Locate and install the Driver and Passenger Wings (Items 2-3) using the M8 hardware. See Figure 17 for reference.
- 17. Align and adjust the Wings as necessary. Tighten and torque all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs.
