






PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting at the front of the vehicle, remove the two bolts next to the tow hooks on either side of the vehicle. See **Figure 1** for reference.
- 3. Remove the two bolts securing the bumper support straps to either side of the bumper. See **Figure 2** for reference.







- 4. Remove the three trim fasteners that secure the rubber trim to the bumper. See **Figure 3** for reference.
- 5. If the vehicle is equipped fog lights disconnect the wiring harness. With assistance remove the entire bumper assembly and set it aside.
- 6. Remove the three bolts securing each tow hook to the frame. See **Figures 4 & 5** for reference. <u>Note</u>: Factory tow hooks cannot be reused. On vehicles with factory frame brackets remove the nuts from the factory bolt plates on the inner side of the frame. See **Figure 5** for reference.







7. Locate and loosely install the Mounting Brackets (Items 4-5) to the frame and the factory double bolt plate using the factory nuts. For the tow hook mounting points, use (3) M10 hex head bolts, (6) M10 flat washers, (3) M10 lock washers, and (3) M10 hex nuts to attach each bracket. See **Figures 6 & 7** for reference. *Note*: It may be necessary to loosen the nuts on the opposite side if the frame bracket springs back excessively. Also, if your vehicle is not equipped with front frame brackets, (1) spacer plate must be placed between the mounting bracket and the inside of the frame. In this case, the factory double bolt plate will not be on the vehicle, so the mounting bracket must be attached using (2) M12 hex head bolts (4) M12 flat washers, (2) M12 lock washers, and (2) M12 hex nuts.








- 8. The bumper may be re-installed at this time. The mounting bracket hardware may need to be loose in order to allow room for adjustment. Use the factory hardware on the outer tab of the winch tray mounting brackets as it takes the place of the factory mounting tab on previously removed tow hooks.
- 9. Locate and loosely mount the Winch Tray (Item 1) on top of the installed mounting brackets using (6) M12 hex head bolts, (12) M12 flat washers, (6) M12 lock washers, and (6) M12 hex nuts (Items 5-8). See **Figure 8** for reference.
- 10. Align and adjust the factory bumper and Winch Tray as needed then fully tighten all hardware at this time. Torque all M10 hardware to 30-35 ft-lbs., and M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs. *Note:* If installing a grille guard kit, leave all hardware loose until grille guard and spacers have been attached.
- 11. If installing a winch, do so at this time per the winch manufacture's instructions. *Note:* If installing a grille guard, many winches must be installed prior to installing the grille guard to avoid any clearance issues.



- 12. To install the grille guard, take the HDX Grille Guard Base and align it to the outside of the previously installed Winch Tray. Loosely mount the grille guard to the winch tray using (4) short M12 button head bolts, (8) M12 flat washers, (4) M12 lock washers, and (4) M12 hex nuts (Items 17-20). See **Figure 9** for reference.
- 13. To mount the grille guard to the mounting bracket locate (2) 13MM round spacers (Item 16) and place them between the mounting bracket and the grille guard. Loosely mount the grille guard to the mounting bracket using (2) long M12 button head bolts, (4) M12 flat washers, (2) M12 lock washers, and (2) M12 hex nuts (Items 18-21). See **Figure 10** for reference.
- 14. Locate and mount the HDX Wings (Items 14-15) to the Grille Guard Base using the supplied M8 Hardware (Items 22-24). See **Figures 9 & 11** for reference. <u>Note</u>: For the mounting hole shared with Winch Tray mounting bracket, the M12 Hardware previously mentioned in step 12 will be used.
- 15. Align and adjust the HDX Grille Guard Base, Wings, Winch Tray, and mounting brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 hardware to 16-18 ft-lbs., M10 hardware to 30-35 ft-lbs., and M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.
