
PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the factory tow hooks (if equipped). They cannot be re-used.
- 3. One side at a time slip the Winch Tray Inner Mounting Brackets and the Winch Tray Outer Mounting Brackets through the two tow kooks pockets. *Note*: Do not fasten either bracket until both have been properly positioned.
- 4. Loosely attach the Winch Tray Outer Mounting Brackets to the vehicle's frame using the supplied M12 Flange Bolts as shown in **Figure 1**. *Note*: The flange bolts may be held in place using the M12 Poly Retainers while positioning the bracket.
- 5. Loosely attach the Winch Tray Inner Mounting Brackets to the vehicle's frame using M12 Hardware as shown in **Figure 2**. *Note*: the large M12 Washer covers the large hole in the frame.






- 6. Using the supplied M12 Hardware loosely attach both mounting brackets to the frame holes that were used for the tow hooks as shown in **Figure 3**.
- 7. Position the Middle Winch Tray Mounting Brackets as shown in **Figure 4** then loosely attach them using the supplied M10 hardware.
- 8. Loosely attach the Inner and outer Mounting Brackets together using M10 hardware as shown in **Figure 4**.





- 9. Loosely attach the winch tray to the brackets using M10 hardware on the sides and M12 hardware on the bottom of the tray as shown in **Figure 5**.
- 10. Install the winch per the winch manufacturer's instructions.
- 11. If installing a Winch Mount Grille Guard continue to **Step 12**. Otherwise align and adjust the tray and brackets as necessary then tighten and torque all fasteners: M10 to 30-35 ft-lbs.; M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.




- 12. If installing a Winch Tray Mount Grille Guard remove the vehicle's radiator cover and grille as shown in Figure 6 & 7.
- 13. Remove the factory M12 bumper bolts from each side as shown in **Figure 8**.
- 14. Install the Support Straps by re-using the factory bumper bolts. Center the Support Straps and space them 42-3/4" apart (outside edge to outside edge). Tighten and torque these fasteners to 50-55 ft-lbs. Refer to **Figure 9**.







Remove all of the screws holding the grille to the upper radiator support and carefully pull it from the vehicle. Note: there are several inaccessible clips that provide some retention on the grille. They will pop loose when you pull on the grille.






- 15. Re-install the vehicle's grille and plastic cover in the reverse order that they removed. *Notes:* the bottom of the grill may need to be squeezed past the Support Brackets.
- 16. Remove the bolts from the Winch Tray shown in **Figure 10.**
- 17. Use an assistant to line up the Spacer Blocks with the Winch Tray as shown in Figure 11.






- 18. While the assistant holds the Spacer Blocks in place, position the Grille Guard over the Spacer Blocks and loosely attach it to the Support Straps using the short M10 Button Head Hardware (items 24, 25, 26).
- 19. Attach the Grille Guard Base to the Winch Tray using the long M10 Button Head Hardware (items 7, 8, 9, 23, 25). These bolts need to go through the Grille Guard Base, Spacer Blocks, Outer Mount Brackets and Winch Tray. *Note:* nuts and washers from the winch tray bolt kit need to be used to accomplished this.
- 20. Locate and install the Grille Guard Driver and Passenger Wings using the M8 hardware (items 27, 28, 29). See **Figure 12** for reference.
- 21. Align and adjust the Grille Guard Base and both Wings as needed. Then fully tighten all hardware at this time. Tighten and torque all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs., M10 30-35 ft-lbs., and M12 50– 55 ft-lbs.
