ANTI-SEIZE LUBRICANT MUST BE USED ON ALL STAINLESS STEEL FASTENERS TO PREVENT THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING.

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and undamaged. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation. Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove plastic cover by front mud guard, see Figure 1.




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
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
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
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- 3. Remove factory M6 hardware and replace with supplied M6 button head bolts and M6 flat washers, See Figure 2 and 5.
- 4. Remove front rubber covers from rocker panel then install supplied M8 U-Clip Nuts into the designated areas, see Figure 3 and 4. (Note: U-Clips only used on front mounting location.)
- 5. Loosely install Front Mounting Bracket to the rocker panel with supplied M6 hardware by placing the bracket flush with factory welded nuts, see Front Assembly and Figure 5. (Note: Do not remove factory welded nuts.)
- 6. Loosely install Front Mounting Bracket to M8 U-Clip Nuts with supplied M8 hardware, see Front Assembly and Figure 4.
- 7. Remove the factory bolt from the front rubber body mount and replace it with a M14 hex screw. Loosely install Front Support Strap to body mount using M14 hex screw, see Figure 5,6, and Front Assembly. Note: The supplied round spacer (Item 25) must go in-between the front support strap (Item 7) and the factory metal mounting cup. See Front Assembly.
- 8. On the rear of vehicle remove rubber covers on the rocker panel, similar to Figure 3.
- 9. Loosely install Rear Mounting Bracket using supplied M8 Bolt Plates and M8 hardware. Guide M8 bolt plates through the revealed holes beneath the rubber covers on rocker panel. (Note: Crew cab model has different hole placements compared to the extended cab model.) Figure 8 shows the crew cab model hole placement. Extended cab models have the small and big hole right next to each other. Rear Mounting Bracket has a slot to accommodate difference between the two models, see figure 9. Use the poly retainers to prevent the bolt plates from falling into the rocker panel. See Rear Assembly, Figure 7, 8, and 9.
- 10. Loosely install Step Bar Assembly to Front and Rear Mounting Brackets using supplied 1/2" hardware, see Front Assembly and Rear Assembly.
- 11. *For crew cab vehicles* remove factory bolt from center body mount similar to Figure 6. Loosely install Center Support Strap to body mount and to step bar with the factory bolt and supplied 3/8" hardware, see Figure 10. Note: No spacer is needed.
- 12. Align and adjust the Step Bar as necessary. Tighten and torque all hardware: M6 to 7 ft-lbs., M8 to 15 ft-lbs., M10 to 20-25 ft-lbs., 1/2 to 45-50 ft-lbs., M14 to 75-80 ft-lbs.
- 13. Reinstall all plastic covers removed during installation process.













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
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
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
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















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




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CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.

DRILLING:
