





PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Take off the (4) original Phillips screws that are located on the rear window of the truck cap. See **Figures 1-3** as reference.



- 3. Stick the (4) Rubber Strips (Item 3) onto the back of the Rear Mesh (Item 1) (Fig 4).
- 4. Attach the mesh to the rear window with the provided (4) M6 Phillip Screws (Item 2) (Fig 5).





Adjust the Rear Door Mesh Protector to the appropriate position. Tighten all bolts M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs and all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs.

The installation of your EXP Truck Cap Rear Door Mesh Protector is complete!
