PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Preassemble the Mounting Brackets (Items 3-7) loosely. Do not tighten hardware at this time. See **Figure 1** for reference.



- 3. Starting on the passenger side of the vehicle, locate the three mounting locations on the rocker panel.
 - Note A: The rear mounting location is shown in Figure 2. Other mounting locations are similar.
 - **Note B:** The two lower studs may have excessive amounts of paint from the factory. To avoid damage to studs, it is strongly recommended that the paint is removed using an M8-1.25 die or a wire wheel. If you feel any resistance while threading the nuts on these studs, stop and clean the stud again to avoid cross threading. Anti-seize compound may also be used to avoid any damage to the studs and to the M8 hardware.




4. At the rear passenger side mounting location, loosely install Mounting Bracket Base (Item 7) with preassembled Passenger Rear Mounting Bracket (Item 3) using the supplied M8 hardware. See **Figures 3 & 4** for reference.







5. At the center passenger side mounting location, loosely install Mounting Bracket Base (3) with preassembled Passenger Center Mounting Bracket (Item 6) using the supplied M8 hardware. See **Figures 5 & 6** for reference.





- 6. At the front passenger mounting location, loosely install the Mounting Bracket Base (Item 7) with preassembled Passenger Front Mounting Bracket (Item 4).
- 7. Repeat Steps 4 through 7 on the driver side of the vehicle with the appropriate brackets. See Figures 7 & 8 for reference.
- 8. Fasten the Outlaw Step Bars (Items 1 & 2) respectively to either side using the M10 hardware provided. See **Figure 9** for reference.
- 9. Align and adjust the Outlaw Step Bars as needed and fully tighten all hardware. Torque all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs. and all M10 hardware to 35-38 ft-lbs.




