




PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on the driver side, remove the rubber plugs located on the rocker panel at each mounting location. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. **For models with threaded holes:** At each bracket mounting location on the rocker panel there should be a welded factory nut.




4. Locate (1) Driver Mount Bracket. Loosely secure Driver Mount Bracket to the rocker panel using (2) M8 hex head bolt long, (2) M8 flat washer, and (2) M8 lock washer. See **Figure 3.** Refer to **Page 4** bracket orientation figures.


- 5. Loosely preinstall the Bracket Covers to the Mounting Brackets using the included M6 Hardware. See Figure 2.
- 6. Partially install the M8 Hardware in the bottom of the rocker panel and then slide the Mounting Brackets into place and install the remaining M8 Hardware. See **Figures 3 & 4.**





- 7. Attach the Bottom Isolator Bracket to the Top Isolator Bracket using the Isolator Kit hardware. See Figure 4.
- 8. Under the front of the bed, there is two factory bolts as shown in **Figure 5.** Remove these bolts.
- 9. Using Preexisting factory bolts, mount the isolator bracket assembly in between the bed and factory bed bracket. **See Figures 4-6**








Shorter bed shown, wheel wells will be back further on 8 ft. bed.



- 10. Fasten step bars respectively to either side using the included M10 hardware. See Figure 7.
- 11. Align and adjust the step bars as needed and fully tighten all hardware. Torque all M6 fasteners to 5-7 ft-lbs, all M8 fasteners to 15-18 ft-lbs, and all M10 fasteners to 30-35 ft-lbs.






