
## **PROCEDURE**

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
  Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
  Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting at the driver side front use 12mm socket to remove the two rocker panel bracket hex cap screws. Repeat same process for center and rear brackets. See **Figures 1 & 2**


- 3. Locate Front Mount Bracket (Item 2) and loosely install using supplied M8 hardware. Repeat for all other mount locations. See **Figure 3**
- 4. Before installing board to the previously installed brackets tilt backwards for easy entry into mount location. See Figure 4









- 5. Loosely install board to previously mounted brackets with suppled M8 hardware. See Figures 5 (Note: See **Figures 6 & 7** for bracket orientation.
- 6. Align and adjust to preferred fitment then torque all M8 hardware to 16 ft-lbs.










## Care Instructions
