


PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Start installation on driver's side. Remove factory tape covering holes on the rocker panel. These holes will be where the M8 extruded u-nuts (Item 7) will be installed. **See Figures 1 and 2.**
- 3. Hold up front/rear mounting bracket (Items 2/3 (front) or Items 5/6 (rear)) and loosely install (2) M8 hex head cap screws (Item 8), (2) M8 flat washers (Item 9) and (2) M8 split lock washers (Item 10) into previously installed M8 extruded unuts. Then loosely install M8 hardware to mounting bracket and holes in pinch weld; (2) M8 hex head cap screws (Item 12), (4) M8 flat washers (Item 13), (2) M8 split lock washers (Item 11) and (2) M8 hex nuts. Similar installation for center mounting bracket. See Figures 1 and 2. (Note: See page 2 for bracket orientation).












- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 for all other mounting locations.
- 5. For Step Board installation to the previously installed mounting brackets use the supplied M8 hardware (Items 8-10). **See Figures 3 and 4.**
- 6. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M8 hardware to 20 ft-lbs.


