



PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.

 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


 Failure to identify damage before installation and lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Start the installation on the driver side. On the rocker panel find the mounting locations with factory studs. In each location there should be 3 studs. See **Figure 1** for reference.
- 3. Insert (1) M8 Plastic Retainer (Item 12) on each factory stud. See Figure 2 for reference.







- 4. Insert the M8 round head square neck bolt (Item 11) through the Universal Mounting Bracket's (Item 7) square hole. Then insert the M8 round head square neck bolt through the corresponding mounting brackets (Items 2 6) on the bottom circular hole. Loosely secure them with (1) M8 hex nut, (1) M8 split lock washer, and (1) M8 flat washer. See **Figure 3** for reference.
- 5. Align the bracket sub-assembly with the 3 factory studs. The lower two factory studs will align with the Universal Mounting Bracket and top factory stud will align with the mounting bracket itself. Loosely secure the sub-assembly with (3) M8 hex nut, (3) M8 split lock washer, and (3) M8 flat washer. See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 6. Repeat steps 3-5 for the front, center, and rear mounting locations on both the passenger and driver side of the vehicle.


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





- 7. Locate the two mounting locations at the rear of the cab of the truck. There will be an opening to insert the supplied nut clips (Item 15). Locate Mounting Bracket A (Item 23) and loosely install it with the supplied M8 hardware. See **Figure 5** for reference.
- 8. Locate the Top Isolator mounting area underneath the bed, at the front of the rear wheel well. There will be a portion of the bed with two large holes where the Bolt Plate (Item 25) will be mounted. Locate the Top Isolator Bracket (Item 5) and loosely install it with the supplied M10 hardware. See **Figures 6 & 7** for reference.










9. Install the Bottom Isolator Bracket (Item 21) to previously mounted Top Isolator Bracket (Item 5) with the supplied Isolator Kit (Item 26) and M12 Hardware. Assemble loosely to allow room for adjustment. See **Figure 8** for reference.



- 10. For step board installation, use the supplied M8 hardware with the short M8 bolts on Mounting Bracket A (Items 23-24) and M8 hardware with long M8 bolts for all other mounting locations. See **Figures 9 & 10** for reference. <u>Note:</u> Reference for bracket locations and orientations can be seen in **Figure 11**.
- 11. Align and adjust the step bar and mounting brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs., M10 to 35-38 ft-lbs., and M12 to 55-60 ft-lbs.
