









DRIVER SIDE ITEMS SHOWN; PASSENGER SIDE ITEMS OPPOSITE




PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation. Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

Body Style "A" Instructions


- 2. Begin by removing the plastic clips holding the air intake splash shield in place, and remove the splash shield.
- 3. Remove the fasteners holding the grille in place. Also, dethatch the clips from the wings on the grille. See **Figures 1 & 2** for reference.
- 4. Remove the grille by pulling firmly and carefully at the bottom of the grille.





- 5. Use the OEM hardware to secure the Upper Strap Bracket (Items 4-5) to the bumper. <u>Note</u>: Bumper shown off of the vehicle for viewing purposes. See **Figure 3** for reference.
- 6. Reinstall the grille and the air intake splash shield.



Body Style "B" Instructions

- 7. Remove the three fasteners retaining the panel above the bumper from the inside of the wheel wells. See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 8. Remove the trim panel from the clips near the headlights. Use a pry tool if necessary. See **Figure 5**.







- 9. On both sides of the vehicle, use a pry tool to remove the fascia panel from the clips shown. See **Figures 6 & 7** for reference.
- 10. Remove the fascia panel above the bumper. *Note:* The fascia panel contains plastic clips retaining it to the rest of the vehicle. Pull firmly and carefully on the fascia to remove it.








- 11. Remove the plastic clips holding the air intake splash shield in place, and remove the splash shield.
- 12. Remove the fasteners retaining the grille. There are 4 fasteners along the top and three along the bottom. See **Figures 8 &** 9 for reference.
- 13. Remove the grille from the clips above the headlights. See **Figure 9** for reference.
- 14. Remove the grille by firmly and carefully pulling it away from the vehicle.
- 15. Trim and apply foam tape to the Upper Support Straps (Items 23-24). See Figure 10 for reference.
- 16. Use the OEM hardware to install the Upper Support Straps to the bumper. See Figures 11 & 12 for reference.
- 17. Adjust the support straps and torque the OEM hardware to 32 ft-lbs.












- 18. Reinstall the grille.
- 19. Reinstall the fascia panel above the bumper.

Body Style "A" Trimming Instructions

20. Carefully trim the factory tow hook pocket area to fit the Lower Mounting Brackets (Items 2-3). See **Figure 13** for reference.

Proceed to Step 22.





Body Style "B" Trimming Instructions

21. Carefully trim the factory tow hook pocket <u>and</u> lower valence area to fit the Lower Mounting Bracket (Items 2-3). See **Figures 14 through 16** for reference.


Notes:

- Make sure you remove the rubber tow hook covers prior to trimming.
- Some vehicle trims do not have the chrome lower valence, but trimming of the plastic valence is still required.
- It is recommended to use blue masking tape to protect the area around the tow hook pocket from scratches or damage.
- It is recommended to incrementally trim, and test fit the brackets as you trim, to avoid over trimming the tow hook pocket and lower valence area.












22. Install the Lower Mounting Brackets (Items 2-3) and Lower Support Straps (Item 6) to the frame using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures 17 through 19** for reference. *Note:* The vehicle frame rails are not opposite of one another.









- 23. Use the supplied M10 (Items 12-14) and M12 Hardware (Items 15-17) to secure the grille guard center to the previously installed mounting brackets. See **Figures 20 through 22** for reference.
- 24. Use the supplied M8 hardware (Items 20-22) to secure the HDX Driver and Passenger Wings to the grille guard base. See **Figure 22** for reference. *Note:* The mounting hole shared with the upper support strap uses M10 hardware.
- 25. Adjust the grille guard base, HDX wings, and mounting brackets to the desired positioning. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 to 18 ft-lbs., M10 to 32 ft-lbs., and M12 to 55 ft-lbs.
