



PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. If equipped, start by removing the front license plate holder. There are two bolts behind the license plate. See **Figure 1** for reference. *Note*: The factory license plate holder cannot be re-used. A license plate relocation kit is sold separately.




FACTORY TOW HOOK REMOVAL


Note: This also applies to vehicles without tow hooks.

- 3. Unbolt the two bolts holding the factory tow hooks. These bolt locations are also used for supplied brackets later on. See **Figure 2** for reference. *Note:* Factory tow hooks cannot be re-used.
- 4. There is a retainer washer inside the frame that holds in the body bolt after loosening it. Using a wrench and a hammer, tap the wrench on the bolt until it falls out. See **Figure 3** for reference.







5. Move to the inner plastic pods where the factory tow hooks go through. Remove the two nuts on top of the pod. Slide the pod out and repeat on other side. See **Figures 4 & 5** for reference.






6. Slide the Winch Tray Brackets (Items 2-3) into the exposed holes in the bumper. Using the supplied M14 hardware and factory body bolts, loosely install the brackets into the factory holes (from **Figure 2**). See **Figure 6** for reference.







7. Using the supplied M10 hardware, install the Lower Reinforcement Straps (Items 4-5) onto the front core support and winch tray bracket. See **Figures 8 through 10** for reference.









- 8. Set the Winch Tray (Item 1) on top of the brackets. See **Figure 11** for reference.
- 9. Loosely install the Winch Tray using the supplied M12 Hardware. See Figure 12 for reference.
- 10. Adjust the winch tray and torque down all the hardware as specified: M10 to 35 ft-lbs., M12 to 60 ft-lbs., M14 to 100 ft-lbs.







Grille Guard Installation (57-33975 only)

- 11. Slide the Grille Guard Base (Item 18) on to the MAX Winch Tray assembly.
- 12. Loosely install the Grille Guard Base on to the winch tray and the winch tray brackets using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures 13 & 14** for reference.





- 13. Using supplied M8 hardware, mount the Driver and Passenger Wings to the Grille Guard Base. See **Figure 15** for reference.
- 14. Adjust the Grille Guard Base, HDX Wings, and mounting brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque M8 hardware to 15 ft-lbs. M10 to 35 ft-lbs., and M12 to 50 ft-lbs.
