


PROCEDURE


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

NOTE: This bumper is compatible with the OEM hitch by removing a non structural component of the hitch. See procedure for details.


- 2. Start removing the rear bumper by removing the plastic portion. It should pop off of the vehicle. You may need a trim removal tool.
- 3. Remove the 5 bolts on each side of the bumper to remove the end caps. See Figure 1-2





- 5. In order to use OEM hitch, grind off the 5 welds holding the license plate sheet metal part. After removal, the hitch should look as shown on Fig. 3. Spray paint the raw metal to avoid rust.
- 6. After modifying the hitch, mount back on the vehicle with frame brackets **Items 2,3** using M12 hardware **Items 9-12. See Fig. 4**







PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION *If not installing sensors, install Hole Plugs into holes on bumper and proceed.


- 5. Remove the parking sensors from the OEM bumper. Pay attention to the orientation of the sensors. They must be installed in the same orientation. Handle sensors with care, they are very delicate.
- 6. Use the Sensor Tab (6) along with the supplied M6 Hardware (14,16-19)to install the sensors as shown in **Figure 5-6.**
- 7. Carefully route the harness around the bumper.

Note: Zip ties or double sided tape can be used to route harness and to hold the sensor in position.






- Using the supplied M12 hardware, loosely assemble the bumper to the mounting brackets(4,5). See Figures 7-8
- 9. Use items 9-12 M12 hardware to mount frame bracket items 2 and 3 to frame and hitch.
- 10. Align bumper and make sure that it has enough clearance with open tailgate.
- 11. Torque all M6 hardware to 7-9 ft-lbs and M12 hardware to 70-80 ft-lbs,




LIGHT INSTALLATION

- 1. Disconnect the battery from your vehicle.
- 2. Locate the license plate lights (pre-installed) in the bumper. Pop out the lights by squeezing the clips in on the backside. **See Figure 9**
- 3. Locate the factory wiring for the license plate lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire. **See Figure 10**







4. Push the light back in until it clips into place. Repeat on the opposite side. See Figure 11



- 5. Remove the light from the rubber grommet. Install the rubber grommet into the back up light location on the bumper. Then, reinstall the light into the rubber grommet. See Figure 12-13
- 6. Looking at the backside of the lower reverse lights, there are three wires: a ground wire, optional (off road only) tail light wire, and a reverse light (bright) wire. Using the figure below, connect the reverse light wire to the factory reverse light harness, and ground wire to a factory ground wire. If using the optional tail light wire, connect the Tail light wire to a switch. See Figure 13
- 7. Reconnect your battery.




