



1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.







2. Remove stock bumper.

- a. Remove plastic valence from the front of each wheel well by removing the plastic clips with a pry tool.
- b. Disconnect all electrical connections to the bumper.
- c. Remove the lower valence from the bottom of the bumper by removing the three screws holding it place.
- d. Remove the tow hooks Note: factory tow hooks will be reused. Save associated hardware.
- e. Remove the four nuts indicated in **Figure 1** from the driver's side of the vehicle. Repeat procedure on the passenger's side. *Note*: Save the hardware from these eight bolts.
- f. Remove stock bumper.





3. Using the supplied M12 Fish Wire, pull the M12 bolt plates through the inside of the frame. Use M12 plastic retainers to hold the bolt plates in place. See Figure 1-2







4. Locate the driver/passenger support brackets. Using both factory and the supplied M12 bolt plate, assemble the support bracket to the frame. **See Figure 3-4**






- 5. Using factory and supplied M12 hardware, assemble the winch mount to the frame and support brackets. See Figure 5-6
- 6. Install your winch to the winch mount per manufacturer's instructions.







7. Locate both main mounting brackets. Using supplied M12 hardware, assemble the mounting brackets to the winch mount. See Figure 7





- 8. Disconnect the sensor harness from the parking sensors from the factory bumper. Pull the plastic U-clip off the sensor and remove the sensor from the inside-out.
- 9. Using the optional sensor brackets, install the sensors from the outside-in to the sensor brackets. *Ensure sensors remain in the correct orientation and location as before.* Replace the U-clip and harness on the sensors. **See Figure 8**
- 10. Using supplied M6 hardware, install the sensor plates. If you do not have sensors, install the optional mesh covers (item 7). See Figure 9






- 11. If installing a light bar, install using the supplied LED light brackets and supplied M6 hardware, if applicable. Install light per manufacturers recommendation. **See Figure 10**
- 12. If you are not installing light bar, install the led light mesh cover using supplied M6 hardware. See Figure 11
- 13. If using light pods, install at this time.





- 14. With help, install the bumper on to the main mounting brackets. Use the supplied M12 hardware. **See Figure 12**15. Adjust as needed and torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft. lbs, M8 to 18 ft-lbs, M10 to 35 ft-lbs, M12 to 55-60 ft-bs.


