




PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on the bottom of the vehicle's front bumper, remove the plastic clips and OEM hardware. See **Figures 1 & 2** for reference.
- 3. Locate and remove the two plastic retaining clips and fasteners in the inner wheel well of the vehicle as shown in **Figure 3**. *Note*: Remove the two plastic retaining clips then pull back the plastic trim to access the two fasteners shown.
- 4. Start to carefully pry on the retaining clips shown in **Figures 4 & 5** along the top of the fascia trim of the vehicle. *Note:* The plastic retainers need to be removed carefully in order to be able to reinstall the fascia trim.













- 5. Carefully remove the Intelligent Cruise Control Module by disconnecting the wiring harness clip and removing the 3 factory nuts shown in **Figure 6**. *Note:* Be very careful not to drop the module as it is expensive to replace.
- 6. Remove the Intelligent Cruise Control Module mounting bracket by removing the factory hardware. See **Figure 7** for reference.
- 7. Remove the OEM crash bar by removing the two factory bolts at the locations shown in **Figure 8** on both the driver and passenger side.










- 8. If you are installing a winch or LED lights, install them at this time per the manufacture's installation instructions. See **Figures 9 & 10** for reference. <u>Note:</u> You may use the supplied LED Light Brackets and M8 hardware to mount LED lights, but it will depend on the LED lights being installed.
- 9. Locate the ICC Relocator Bracket (Item 4) and the supplied M6 hardware (Items 6-9) and mount the ICC module as shown in **Figure 11.** *Note:* It is important to mount the ICC Module center and parallel to the top and bottom edges of the relocation bracket.









10. Using the supplied M4 hardware (Items 19-20), mount the ICC Relocator Bracket, module, and ICC Module Shield, as shown in **Figures 12 & 13.** <u>Note:</u> It is important to mount the ICC module center relative to the shield and bumper to avoid any module obstructions.






- 11. With assistance, mount the Pro Series Bumper assembly to the vehicle frame using the OEM hardware. See **Figures 14 & 15** for reference. *Note*: *Make sure that there are no wires pinched between the mounting locations and the bumper assembly.*
- 12. Reconnect the Intelligent Cruise Control module. <u>Note:</u> Make sure the wiring harness and connector are not pinched by the bumper assembly or any of the mounting brackets.






13. Carefully remove and separate the plastic fascia weldments along the bumper in order to isolate the upper fascia trim. Reinstall this trim to the vehicle. See **Figures 16 through 18** for reference. <u>Note</u>: A Dremel or cutting tool and a heat gun may be used to trim these plastic weldments or a plastic pry tool may be used to separate them. Be **VERY** careful when separating these plastic weldments in order to avoid leaving openings in the fascia of the vehicle.










14. Locate and install the Driver and Passenger Side Support Brackets (Items 2 & 3) with the supplied M12 hardware to the frame tow hook mounting locations as shown in **Figures 19 & 20.** <u>Note:</u> The fine thread M12 bolts will be used for the two hook locations and the course thread bolts will be used to mount the support brackets to the Pro Series Bumper.







- 15. Reinstall the plastic retaining clips to the vehicle's fascia on both the driver and passenger side as shown in Figure 21.
- 16. Using the supplied M8 hardware, mount the OEM plastic undertray to the two mounting locations on the Pro Series bumper assembly as shown in Figure 22.






- 17. If your vehicle is equipped with a factory Pro4X skid plate, mount the skid plate brackets to the same hardware installed during **Step 14**. See **Figures 23 & 24** for reference.
- 18. Install factory Pro4X skid plate the on to the brackets as shown in Figure 25.
- 19. Align and adjust the Pro Series bumper as necessary. Tighten and torque the hardware as specified: M6 hardware to 7-9 ft.-lbs., M8 hardware to 15-18 ft.-lbs., M10 hardware to 35-38 ft.-lbs., and M12 hardware to 58-60 ft-lbs.
