





#### **PROCEDURE**

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
   Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
   Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Unbolt the factory hitch if equipped.
- 3. Remove all electrical connections from the rear bumper.
- 4. Remove the two bolts on each side of the rear bumper/hitch. See Figure 1-2
- 5. Remove the rear bumper.







#### PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION


\*If not installing sensors, install Hole Plugs into holes on bumper and proceed.


- 6. Remove the parking sensors from the OEM bumper. Pay attention to the orientation of the sensors. They must be installed in the same orientation. Handle sensors with care, they are very delicate.
- 7. Use the Sensor Tab (4) along with the supplied M6 Hardware (11-14) to install the sensors as shown in **Figure 3-5.**
- 8. Carefully route the harness around the bumper.

Note: Zip ties or double sided tape can be used to route harness and to hold the sensor in position.











9. Remove the hitch/support from the OEM bumper. You must **carefully** bend two tabs on the factory hitch in order for the new bumper to fit. Use either a pair of vise grips or a hammer to bend See **Figures 5 and 6 for reference** Reinstall it on the truck.







10. Using supplied M8 hardware, loosely assemble the bumper mounting bracket to the underside of the frame of the truck.

Note: You must install the bracket under the OEM bumper support bracket in order for the new bumper to fit. See Figure 7








13. Install the Trailer plug and license plate, and accessory lights at this time (Black M6 hardware is provided torque to 7 ft.– lbs).

#### WARNING.

After you have mounted bumper on main brackets. CAREFULLY open tailgate. While tailgate is open, adjust the height of the bumper so that it has about 3/8" of clearance with respect to the tailgate. Torque M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs. and M8 to 15-18 ft-lbs

### License plate lights installation.


- 1. Disconnect the battery from your vehicle.
- 2. Locate the license plate lights (pre-installed) in the bumper. Pop out the lights by squeezing the clips in on the backside. **See Figure 10**
- 3. Locate the factory wiring for the license plate lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire. **See Figure 11** Note: Only the portion shown on **Figure 12** will be needed from the connector.








4. Push the light back in until it clips into place. Repeat on the opposite side. See Figure 13



- 5. If you are installing the optional reverse lights, remove the mesh covers and install the optional lights with the M6 hardware. See Figure 14
- 6. Locate the factory wiring for the reverse lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire.
- 7. Reconnect your battery.


