

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.







- 2. Disconnect the electrical plugs from the rear bumper located on each side along the frame rail.
- 3. Remove the 3 OEM bolts on each side of the rear bumper. See Figure 1 for reference.
- 4. Carefully remove the rear bumper. *Note*: *Assistance may be needed removing the bumper*.



5. Once the OEM bumper is removed from the vehicle, remove the OEM parking sensors and the OEM wiring harness. Remove the sensors carefully by using a flat head screwdriver or pry tool to remove the sensors as shown. See **Figures 2 through 4** for reference.










PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION

If not installing the parking sensors, install Hole Plugs into the holes on the bumper and proceed.


- 6. Make sure to reuse the factory rubber grommet to isolate the sensor from the metal.
- 7. Use the Sensor Tab (Item 4) along with the supplied M6 Hardware (items 5-8) to install the sensors as shown in **Figures 5** through 8.
- 8. Carefully route the harness around the bumper. *Note: Zip ties or double sided tape can be used to route the wiring harness and to hold the sensors in position. The wiring harness extensions (Item 12) may also be used as necessary.*








- 9. Install any bumper accessories prior to installing the bumper onto the vehicle.
- 10. Using the OEM hardware, loosely secure the Pro-Series bumper assembly to the OEM mounting locations. See **Figure 8** for reference. *Note:* Assistance may be needed to lift the bumper onto the vehicle.
- 11. Using the supplied M12 bolt plate and M12 hardware (Items 5, 9-11), loosely secure the Pro-Series bumper assembly to the OEM upper mounting locations on both sides of the bumper. See **Figure 9** for reference.






12. After you have mounted bumper on the vehicle, CAREFULLY open the tailgate. While tailgate is open, align and adjust the height of the bumper so that it has about 3/8" of clearance with respect to the tailgate. Tighten and torque M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.
